Final Exams

Exams begin on Monday, June 1 and are completed on Friday June 5. The last day of classes is Friday 5th.

Please check the calendar for specific days subject area exams are scheduled.

Juniors have exams Monday through Friday from 9 -11, and seniors are scheduled from 9 -12. Students are dismissed after their exams, and may leave campus with parental consent, or they may stay for the remainder of the day until 3, except for Wednesday when they leave at 2 and on Friday they are dismissed after their exam.

Friday is a Make-up Day for students who were not able to take an exam due to illness. Students not scheduled for an exam should not come on Friday. Uniforms are to be worn exam week.

Students are asked to take home all their belongings, and have all books returned.
